Bell Times

The first bell rings at 8:20 a.m. We ask that all students arrive at school BEFORE 8:20 a.m. Students are dismissed each day at 3:10 p.m. If you are driving your child to school or picking up at the end of the day, we ask that you please park across the street from the school. Please do NOT park in front of the school as that is where the school buses park to pick up students that ride the bus. If you have not made arrangements for busing, please do so ASAP.
